## Bengal in grip of jungle raj, state terrorism: Nadda

**Kolkata, Sep 28 (IANS)** Blasting the Mamata Banerjee government, BJP Working President J.P. Nadda on Saturday alleged that West Bengal was in the grip of "jungle raj" and "state terrorism" with democracy rendered non-functional through "physical liquidation of political opponents". "There is jungle raj in West Bengal. It is state terrorism. Democracy is not being allowed to function. Democracy is being throttled," Nadda said after performing the Hindu ritual of tarpan -- offering of prayers to the departed -- for party workers killed in political violence in the state recently. He alleged those opposed to the ruling Trinamool Congress ideology were being killed. "Every day, there is physical liquidation of people who have faith in a different political ideology," he told reporters on the banks of the Hooghly river in north Kolkata's Bagbazar. "There is no law and order. The government which has created a jungle raj is neither upholding the law, nor ensuring judicial remedy. Even justice is not being given to the families of victims".
